Junior Section Rules

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the club Chairman, Tony Miles (contact details available upon request).

As a member of West Wilts Junior Hockey Club you are expected to abide by the following junior section rules:

- ⊕ All members must play within the rules of hockey and respect officials and their decisions.
- ⊕ All members must respect opponents.
- ⊕ Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach/ team manager if they are going to be late.
- ⊕ Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions (see list below) as agreed with the coach/ team manager.

- ⊕ Members must pay any subscription fees or event fees promptly.
- ⊕ Junior members are not allowed to smoke on Club premises or whilst representing the Club at competitions.
- ⊕ Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the Club premises or whilst representing the Club.
- ⊕ The behaviour and personal conduct of Members must, at all times, be of a high standard and reflect favourably on the Club. Language must always be appropriate and socially acceptable.
